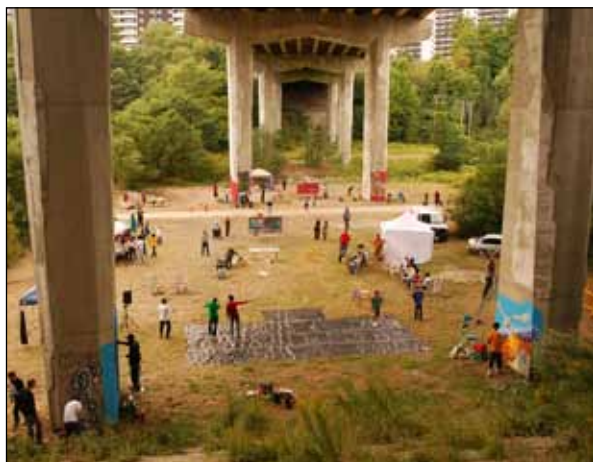

about **SUBTEXT**

SUBTEXT is a dynamic, two-day multi-arts festival that includes community events, projects and workshops.

SUBTEXT features a weekend of free community activities such as music, dance, theatre, storytelling, poetry, interactive visual arts projects, aerosol art, creative workshops and environmental activities. The space beneath the bridge forms a unique amphitheatre created by the soaring support pillars overhead. The festival is part of the summer-long Bridging Project, linking the community above with the natural environment below.

BRIDGING PROJECT

THE BRIDGING PROJECT emerged from the concerns of some residents of Kingston-Galloway/Orton Park, who have talked about the bridge as being an obstacle. Many residents think of the bridge as unsafe. It divides the community in two, creating a barrier between the Kingston-Galloway and Orton Park communities. Residents are sometimes unwilling or unable to cross it in order to access events, activities and services that are located on the opposite side. Through collaboration, the Bridging Project uses creative methods to try to break down barriers, make connections, and help change this perception.

The **PURPOSE** of the Bridging Project is to transform the bridge back into a connector that brings residents from diverse communities together.

The **GOAL** is to engage local artists to work with youth, families, volunteers and the community at large on a variety of art projects that will provide inspiration and education for the participants and leave a legacy for the community.

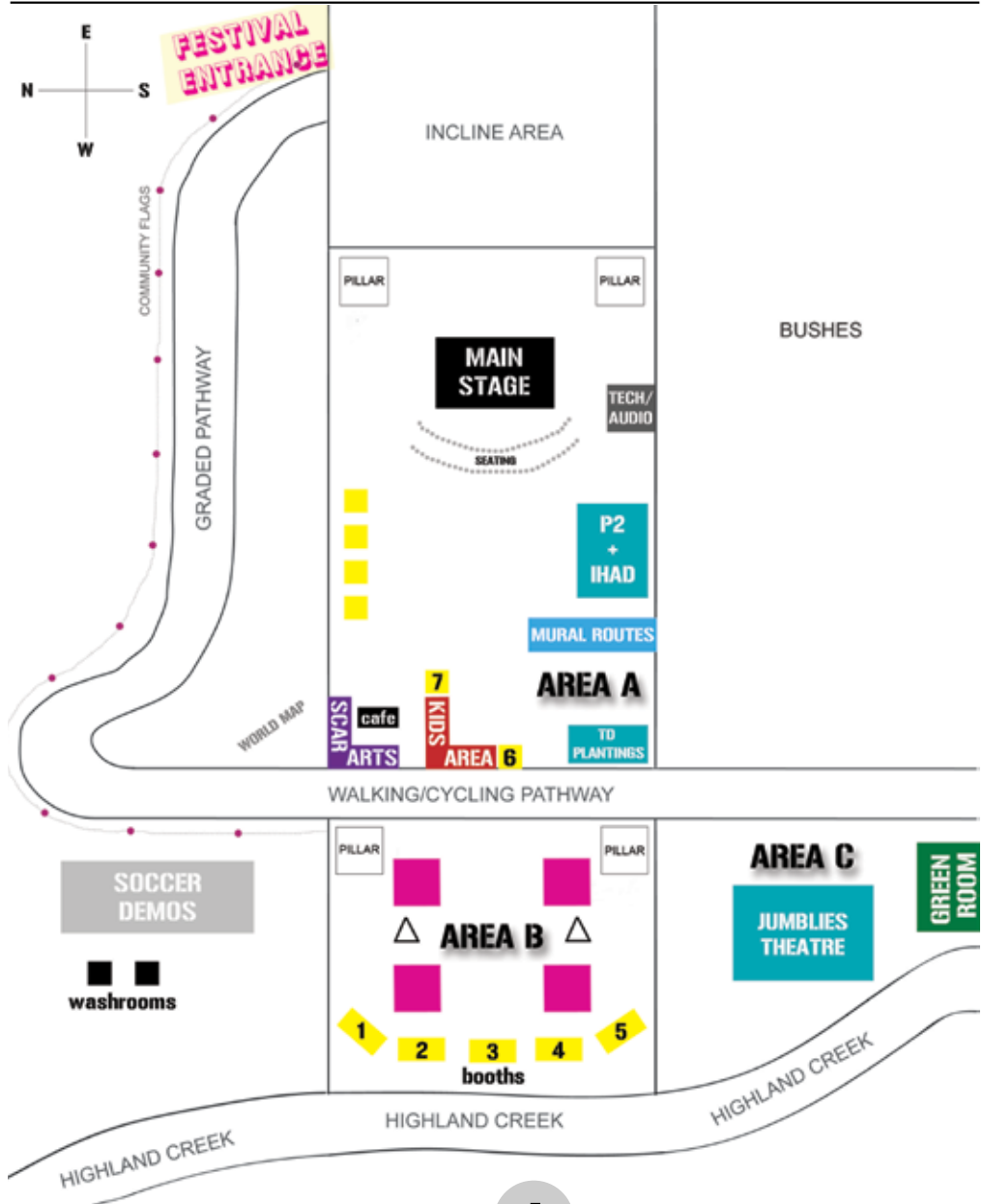

From KENNEDY STATION, take the 86 bus, get off at the Lawrence Ave. stop. A brief walk along Lawrence, and you'll be there.
