The Bridging Festival - 2014 is presented by Scarborough Arts in partnership with the City of Toronto-Arts Services, East Scarborough Storefront, East Scarborough Festival Market, Scarborough Historical Museum, and Toronto and Region Conservation Authority. *The Bridging Festival* is a two day multi-arts festival that brings together Scarborough communities in a celebration of culture and community.

Inaugurated in 2010 -and now five years strong, this year showcases the local talent and cultural wealth of Scarborough communities.

The Bridging Festival plays hosts to two “don’t-miss” events: Variety Night on August 22nd, which features performances, films and food –then, our culminating Arts, Culture and Environmental Festival on August 23rd, which celebrates live visual arts, interactive booths, musical and dance performances and so much more!
